



Fees

You deserve great value for your money – and that’s what you’ll get from University of Birmingham Day Nurseries.

What’s included?

Prices include all meals, snacks and drinks, local excursions, cooking activities and music sessions. Fees are invested back into the nursery, ensuring your child is cared for by staff with the very best skills and training, in a safe, secure and welcoming setting that’s continuously updated with fresh resources and creative opportunities.

Outdoor learning is a priority. Your child will have regular access to Forest School and outdoor spaces,

all year round. They’ll also grow their own fruit and veg, learn about sustainability, and create habitats for wildlife. Through these hands-on sensory experiences, they’ll be developing physical and social skills, building confidence and independence.

Extra activities are also available, from expressive dance and yoga to sports. These classes are optional for a small weekly fee.

3 and over

All children aged 3 and over are entitled to 15 hours funded childcare a week (or 570 hours per year). You can access this from the start of the term after their third birthday (that is, from September, January or April), and we’ll help you arrange it all. You may also be eligible for up to 30 hours funded childcare: it’s your responsibility to apply for this, and to keep it validated every three months. Some children aged 2 are also entitled to funding.

Please note: we’ll always do our very best to offer you a funded space to your full entitlement, but we can’t guarantee availability, and you may still be eligible for nursery fees.
